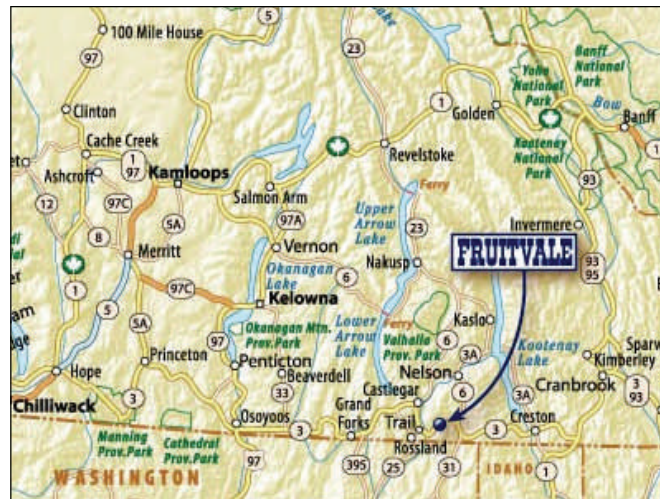

40 Things To Do In Fruitvale

1. View **historical sites and displays** at Park Siding School, Montrose and Fruitvale Village Offices, Kootenay Savings Credit Union (Fruitvale) and Fruitvale Memorial Centre
2. Visit the **Beaver Valley Library** and check out the great selection of new books and magazines, log onto the internet or listen to a guest speaker
3. Enjoy the great food at a variety of **restaurants:** Canadian, Chinese, Greek, Italian, subs, sandwiches and specialty coffees 
4. **Shop our downtown area** for great gifts, sales and specialty items
5. Attend the annual **July 1st BBQ and Volunteer Appreciation Day** hosted by Village Council at Creekside Community Park
6. Bring the kids for a picnic and let them play on the **new playground equipment at Creekside Community and Vale Parks.** 
7. Read the **Village of Fruitvale's monthly newsletter** to get all the latest local news and upcoming events
8. Take your group or family bowling at **BV Lanes.** Reserve a date for laser bowling or a party
9. Attend a **church service** at one of five local churches
10. Take a guided tour of the **Pend d'Oreille River Hydro Dam** at Seven Mile
11. Play **Bingo** every Wednesday night (except during the summer months) at the Fruitvale Memorial Hall
12. Workout on the **new Green Gym equipment** at Creekside Community Park
13. Ask a local fisherman where the **best fishing spots** are on Beaver Creek, local rivers and lakes 

14. Take a rest on one of the many **Memorial Benches** located through out downtown Fruitvale 
15. Check out the **BV Recreation** calendar for activities and courses in crafts, yoga, zumba and more
16. Hike, swim, boat, fish at **Champion Lakes** only a few minutes from town
17. Contact **Senior Citizens Association #44** or visit **Beaver Valley Manor** for seniors information and activities
18. Have a look at the new **Community Bulletin Board kiosk** located in front of Liberty Foods
19. Attend **Beaver Valley May Days** festival held the last weekend in May every year for great family fun. Lots of activities for kids of all ages
20. Check out the **Trail Horseman's Society** activities at the Columbia Gardens Rodeo Grounds
21. Sharpen your skates and attend public skating or drop in hockey at **Beaver Valley Arena** 
22. Take a 20 minute walk from Bluebird corner to view beautiful **Beaver Falls**
23. Day picnicking or camping at **Champion Lakes** is fun for the whole family
24. Watch the Junior B Cyclone Taylor Cup winning **Beaver Valley Nite Hawks** play hockey at the BV Arena
25. Join a team or watch a bonspiel at the **Beaver Valley Curling Rink**
26. Take in 9 holes (or 18 if you feel like it) of great golf at the **Champion Lakes Golf & Country Club**
27. Ski some **great cross country trails** at Champion Lakes groomed by the Cross Country Ski Club 
28. Join one of the many **adult clubs** in Fruitvale ie: BV Rotary Club, BV Lions Club, BV Historical Society, BV Blooming Society, and more.
29. Take in the annual **Craft Fair** at the beginning of November in the Fruitvale Community Hall

30. Have the kids join one of the many **youth clubs** such as Beavers, Scouts, Cubs, Sparks, Brownies, Girl Guides, etc 
31. Kick off the Christmas season on the first Saturday in December at the annual **Jingle Down Main** celebration on Main Street
32. Camp at the **Beaver Valley Family Park** at Marsh Creek
33. Join the **Beaver Valley Snowmobile Club** for some fantastic snowmobiling
34. Take in the Friends of the Library **Garden Tour** every other year near the end of June
35. Have the kids join the **Summer Reading Program** at the BV Library every summer 
36. Support our local charities during **Community Rewards Month** at Liberty Foods by purchasing a hot dog, hamburger, or a sausage on a bun being barbecued by a different local organization in front of Liberty Foods every weekend in May
37. Have the kids join one or more of the many **sports clubs** such as hockey, figure skating, soccer, baseball, curling, girls softball, bowling, and more
38. Book the **Fruitvale Community Hall** for a dance, wedding, birthday/anniversary party
